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



# Leadership Practices Inventory (LPI)

- 5 Practices
  - **10 Commitments**
  - 30 behavior statements
    - 6 behaviors for each of the 5 Practices

How frequently ?

**1** 

 Highly reliable (Spain, China, Australia, Mongolia, Thailand others)

 No differences between males and females (encouraging)

- Higher LPI scores correlate to:
  - Performance, team, commitment, credibility, and satisfaction

 Your <u>self-assessment</u> of how much or how little you use each of the leadership practices

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 A picture of which of the behaviors associated with the Practices that you feel you use most frequently (Page 2)

 A picture of how your view of how much you use each practice compares to how thousands of others think they use that practice
